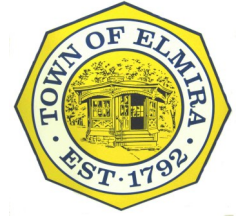

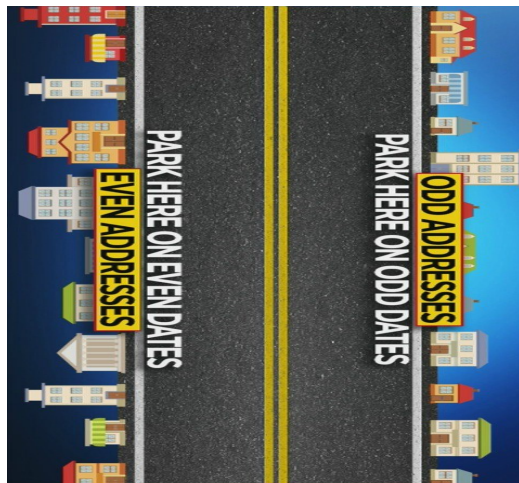

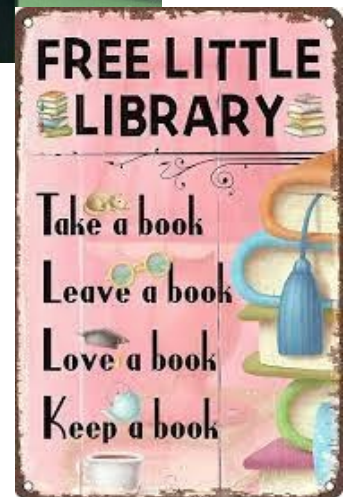

All dogs must be licensed within the municipality in which you reside when the dog reaches 4 months of age. Failure to license or renew a license is a violation of the Code of the Town of Elmira and NYS agriculture and Market Law. Any unlicensed dog may be seized and impounded until a license is obtained. If your dog remains unlicensed, you will be cited for violating Town Code and directed to appear in Town Court.
