Supervisor Gerould discussed the sale of a McCanns Blvd property with the board. The Town Board discussed and agreed that if the agreement honors the existing contract that the Town has with the Family Reading partnership they will go forward with the sale. Attorney Moore stated he's been in contact with Mr. Pickering's attorney and they have agreed to honor the existing agreement.

Town Clerk Stein discussed with the Town Board the new DEC changes regarding the 2024 sale of licenses. The State will no longer supply Velron paper for the licenses and the agents are required to print the licenses on plain copy paper. Clerk Stein stated that the Town may have to do a resolution later to approve a \$1.00 added fee to print out the licenses once DEC gets their changes finalized.

Supervisor Gerould explained that the Friends of Chemung River asked if the Town would allow them to place a storage unit on town property for them to hold canoes, kayaks, and other equipment in to be able to have better access in order to do more camps, trainings, etc. in the town.

Attorney Moore spoke to the Board regarding the Solar fees for the Town. He stated that him and Code Enforcer Crandall have discussed fees for solar developers that want to utilize land in the town. Once these fees are finalized, they will be presented to the Town Board for approval.

Councilmember Bush spoke to the Town Board regarding the Tree committee stating that the committee would like to ask the Town Board to allocate at least \$2000.00 annually for the Tree program.

Councilmember Bush informed the Board that some of the highway's vehicles need to be replaced. The Highway department needs to replace 2 pick up trucks with plows and 2 plow

trucks. He informed the board that once you order a plow truck it takes two years to have it delivered. The East Hill salt barn is also in need of a new cover.

Councilmember Lucarelli spoke about the bear complaints on Hillcrest and the deer population in the Town.

Councilmember Allison informed the board that he spoke with Mr. Palmer regarding the long walk to some of the ball fields and how some people that have a hard time walking aren't able to attend games.
